Vassall Centre

Tracy and Jan from the Carers Centre in Fishponds visited one of our committee meetings and gave us some information which may be of interest to you. The centre cares for residents in Bristol and South Gloucestershire and supports carers of adults or children with a learning disability. Please find listed below the kind of things the centre can help you with.

- 1) Carers' Line open 10am- 1pm Monday- Saturday. Messages can be left at other times. Tel: 0117 965 2200.
- 2) Emergency Card scheme- carers' details kept on computer- who you care for, emergency contact people, who has a key to your house etc. Emergency services staff will recognise the card, and can access the stored information. 1,000 people now on the scheme.
- 3) Share with a carer- out of hours contact line, if you desperately need to speak to someone.
- 4) Sitting service in South Glos- priority given to people who care for someone who has a learning disability.
- 5) Time out/ holidays/ breaks/ trips/ relaxation days for carers- FREE!!!
- 6) Information about charities and organisations who may provide funding towards holidays for disabled person, carer, family, helpers.
- 7) A worker to aid hospital discharge plans, liase with GPs etc- more for adults than children.
- 8) Try to reach male carers- with FREE trips, outings etc.
- 9) FREE Lunch club and spa days for carers.
- 10) Benefit advice.
- 11) Support for children who care for siblings or parents- Young carers' group.
- 12) Complimentary therapies such as Indian Head Massage and Reiki at the Carers' Centre- £12

- 13) Newsletter 4 times a year.
- 14) Emmaus House relaxation day- open to Carers from both areas.
- 15) Carers' support groups which meet at Carers' Centre and other venues.

To get access to all of this, phone 0117 965 2200 (Carers' Line) and ask to be added to the mailing list.

Jan is running an Employment Workshop for learning disabled people and their carers from Bristol. On Friday 4th April, 10.00 am at the Carers' Centre. It is entitled 'An Introduction to Work'. It is hoped that more of these workshops will be held on future dates.
